- Remove the OEM plastic fascia with plastic removal tools use the lever tools in the highlighted area's.
- Once the fascia is unclipped, pull the fascia towards the rear of the vehicle
- 3 Unplug the three OEM connectors from the back of the fascia







- Unscrew the two screws highlighted, then remove the head unit.
- Remove heater controls by removing the screws highlighted then fit the heater controls into the new fascia
- Remove the display by unscrewing the two screws on top of the display. Then unclip the display loom clips where highlighted














- 7 Remove the OEM display connector
- Feed the Connects2 stalk display harness up through the dash As shown in picture
- Connect the Connects2 stalk display connector into the OEM display and refit the display

- 10 Plug the OEM display connector into the Connects2 interface box
- 11 Plug the Stalk loom connector (14 Pin connector) into the interface box
- 12 Plug the connets2 stereo patch lead into the interface
- 13 Plug the main OEM connector into the Connects2 main connector

Remove clips from Connects2 fascia Fit stereo brackets - Dont fully tighten Fit stereo into dash - Test fit


Test fit fascia - manipulated stereo into final postion

Remove fascia

Remove stereo - Being careful not to move the barckets Fully tighten stereo brackets

Re-fit stereo

Re-fit fascia clips



Place the speaker onto the Connects2 fascia and with a soldering iron, melt the four plastic tabs (highlighted in the picture) in the corner of the speaker.

Try the supplied trim around the face of the head unit first before melting into please (highlighted in th picture). If the trim does not fit around face of head unit then trim is not needed














- Connect up the mini speaker connector
- Plug the Connects2 cable into the Hazard and door lock switch connectors at the top of the fascia (Grey switch first)
- Connect the other end of the switch connector cable onto the vehicles
- harness
- Finally fit the fascia into place and the install is complete

to allow the fascia to clip into place correctly

Unclip switch wire from switches and feed the switch connector wires

around the head unit and tidy up the wiring behind the heater controls
