Observe all warnings

All warnings on the product and in the manual must be observed closely.

Follow all instructions

All operating instructions in the manual must be followed.

Do not insert liquids or objects

Liquids or objects could result in fire or electrical shock. Use special caution in households where children are present. If liquids or objects should enter the LED TV, immediately turn off the power switch, disconnect the power plug from the AC outlet and contact the gualified service personnel.

- Do not place the LED TV near the bathtub, bathroom, kitchen sink, wet basement or swimming pool, and the like.
- Do not expose the LED TV to rain or moisture.
- Do not place flower vases, pots, cups, cosmetics, liquids as water, etc on or around the LED TV.
- Do not place metals, combustibles, etc on or around the LED TV.
- Do not drip or splash liquid of any kind on the LED TV.

Do not give the LED TV any shock or impact

If the LED TV should be dropped and/or broken, it could result in an injury, and continued use could result in fire or electrical shock.

If the glass panel is broken or damaged, immediately turn off the power switch, disconnect the power plug from the AC power outlet and contact the qualified service personnel.

Prevent the unit from falling

- Fasten the LED TV to a wall using a cord or chain which is sufficient to support the weight of the LED TV. Before moving the LED TV, the cord or chain should be removed.
- Do not allow children to climb on the LED TV.
- Do not place the LED TV on a bed, sofa, rug, similar surface. Do not place the LED TV on an unstable cart, stand, or table. The LED TV may fall, causing serious damage to the LED TV and/or serious personal injury, death.
- When the product is used on a trolley, care should be taken to avoid quick stops, excessive force, and uneven surfaces that may cause the product and trolley to overturn.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Do not block any ventilation openings

- The vents and other openings in the cabinet are designed to let hot air escape from the LED TV.
 Do not cover or block these vents and openings since insufficient ventilation can cause overheating. Do not place the LED TV on a bed, sofa, rug or other similar surface, since they can block ventilation openings, it may overheating and result in fire.
- Do not cover the LED TV with cloth, such as curtains, or items such as news paper, etc.
- This unit is not designed for built-in installation, do not place the product in an enclosed place such
 as a bookcase or rack, unless proper ventilation is provided or the manufacturer's instructions are
 followed.

Avoid high temperature environment

The heat adversely affect the LED TV and other parts, and could result in serious overheating or risk of fire

- Do not place the LED TV, the remote control and other parts in direct sunlight or near a hot object such as heater, etc.
- Do not put the LED TV in a place where the temperature is widely changing.
- To prevent the spread of fire, keep candles or other open flames away from this product at all times.

Avoid oils

Do not install the LED TV in a place that uses oil. Dust absorbing oil may enter into the unit and damage the unit.

Power cord protection

Incorrect connection of the power cord could result in fire or electrical shock.

- Do not connect too many appliances to the same mains socket as this could result in fire or electrical shock.
- The apparatus shall be connected to a mains socket outlet with a protective earthing connection.
- The socket outlet for connecting mains plug shall be easily accessible and remain readily operable.
- Do not overload wall outlet as this can result in fire or electrical shock.
- Check that the connecting portion of the AC power cord is clean (with no dust), before using. Use a soft and dry cloth to clean the power plug.
- AC power cord should be routed so that they are not likely to be walked on or pinched by items
 placed upon or against it. Also do not put any heavy objects on the AC power cord.
- Do not touch the AC power cord with a wet hand.
- Pull out the AC power cord by the plug. Do not pull on the power cord.
- Insert the power plug into a power outlet firmly. Avoid using a loose, or damaged outlet.
- Do not pinch, bend, or twist the cable excessively. The core lines may be bared or cut, causing a short-circuit which may induce fire or electrical shock.
- For your own safety, do not touch any part of the unit, power cord or aerial lead during lightning storms.
- Do not modify the AC power cord.
- Disconnect the power cord if the LED TV is not used for a long time.
- Switch off and withdraw the power plug before making or changing connections.
- The mains plug is used as disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily operable.

Handing and cleaning the screen surface of display unit

To avoid screen degradation, follow points mentioned below. Do not push on or scratch with hard objects, or throw anything at the screen. The screen may be damaged.

- Be sure to unplug the power cord from outlet before cleaning.
- Do not touch the display panel after operating continuously for a long period as the display panel becomes hot.
- We recommend that the screen surface is touched as little as possible.
- To remove dust from the screen surface, wipe gently with a clean, soft and cotton-free dry cloth.
- Do not use any type of abrasive pad, alkaline/acid cleaner or strong solvent such as alcohol, thinner or benzene etc, as the surface may be impaired.

Cleaning the cabinet

- Be sure to unplug the power cord from the outlet before cleaning.
- Clean the cabinet with a soft cloth.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Note that material deterioration or screen coating degradation may occur if the display unit is exposed to a volatile solvent, such as alcohol, thinner, benzine or insecticide, or if prolonged contact is maintained with rubber or vinyl materials.

Carrying and moving

 Be sure to always carry the LED TV by two people holding it with two hands, one hand on each side of the LED TV. If you carry the unit in a manner other than that specified, it may drop and a serious injury may be caused.

Servicing

Do not open the cabinet or remove the rear cover of the unit. If any of the following conditions occurs, unplug the AC power cord from the AC outlet, and contact qualified service personnel.

- When the power cord or plug is damaged.
- When the LED panel is damaged.
- When the liquid is spilled on the unit or when objects have fallen into the unit.
- When the unit has been exposed to rain or water.
- If the unit has been dropped or the cabinet has been damaged in any way.
- If the unit does not work properly even after you have referred to the TROUBLESHOOTING section.

Replacement parts

- In case the unit needs replacement parts, make sure that the service personnel uses replacement
 parts specified by the manufacturer, or those with the same characteristics and performance as the
 original parts. Use of unauthorized parts can result in fire, electrical shock and/or other danger.
- Upon completion of service or repair work, request the service technician to perform safety checks to ensure that the unit is in proper operating condition.

WARNING: Excessive sound pressure from earphones and headphones can cause hearing loss. Other notices

- Sometimes, the image may have some tiny red, green, blue, white or black spots. This is normal
 and does not affect the performance of the LED TV.
- Due to advanced technology of the LED TV, giving you fine picture details. Occasionally, a few nonactive pixels may appear on the screen as a fixed point of blue, green, or red. Please note that this does not affect the performance of your LED TV.
- If the unit is used in a cold place, a smear may occur in the picture or the picture may become dark.
 This does not indicate a failure. These phenomena improve as the temperature rises.
- In some case, residual images may remain after the short-term display of still images is displayed.
 These will disappear in a few minutes, and the display will return to normal. However, if used in high
 temperatures, it sometimes spends some tens of minutes to return to normal. Please note that this
 is not a malfunction.
- LED panel are made of finely processed glass, so please avoid pushing hands or a strong impact on the panel. It may cause damage to the LC cells, and/or there is danger of glass breakage.
- Do not use immediately after moving from a low temperature to a high temperature environment, as this causes condensation, which may result in fire, electrical shock or other danger.

CONTROL BUTTONS AND TERMINALS

BATTERY INSTALLATION

Insert the batteries while observing the correct (+) and (-) polarities as illustrated below.



About the batteries

- If the remote control unit fails to work even when it is operated near the LED TV, please replace the batteries.
- Use size UM-4 (AAA) batteries.

'Ò' Note:

- Do not use rechargeable (Ni-Cd) batteries.
- Do not attempt to recharge, short circuit, disassemble, heat or throw the batteries into the fire.
- Do not splash the remote control with water or put it on a wet object to avoid possible.
- Do not drop, step on or cause any impact to the remote control unit. This may damage it, resulting malfunction.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- If the remote control unit is not going to be used for a long time, remove the batteries.
- Strong light such as direct sunlight impinging on the remote sensor can cause operational failure. Place the remote control to avoid direct contact with sunlight.

Caution

Keep batteries out of children's reach. If batteries are swallowed, contact a physician immediately.


BASIC CONNECTION

CONNECTING POWER CORD

- 1. Connect the AC/DC Adapter to the DC input socket on the rear of the LED TV, then plug the other end of the power cord into a correctly wall outlet.
- 2 . Turn on the main power switch on the bottom of the LED TV, then press the POWER button on the remote control or the \circlearrowleft button on the key pads to turn on the LED TV .


∜ Note:

use only the AC/DC Adapter provided.



CONNECTING THE RF CABLE

Connect a 75Ω aerial cable to the "RF IN" socket on the rear of the LED TV firmly.



'\' Note:

To view television channel correctly, a signal must be received by the set.

BASIC CONNECTION

- Before connecting any external video equipment, please familiarise yourself with the location and type of each input. If incorrect connections are made, picture or color quality may be adversely affected. Please ensure that all connectors firmly seated.
- Your external equipment such as DVD player, VCR or home theatre system can be connected to the rear of the LED TV so that you can enjoy a complete audio-visual experience.


'Ö' Note:

Before connecting any external equipment, turn off all main power switch or remove the mains plug from the AC outlet for safety.

CONNECTING TO AV OUT CONNTCTOR


1. Connect the AV OUT connector on the external video device to the AV OUT connector on the LED TV using a AV OUT cable.

Yellow cable connector to V terminal(Yellow), White cable connector to L terminal(White), RED cable connector to R terminal(RED).




CONNECTING TO COMPOSITE VIDEO TERMINAL

- 1. Connect the video and audio signal with the AV Conversion cable and RCA cable.
- Press the SOURCE button on the remote control to select AV input source, then press the ENTER button to perform your selection.



CONNECTING TO YPBPR TERMINAL

- 1. Connect the YPBPR signal with the YPBPR Conversion and YPBPR cable.
- 2. Connect the audio signal with the AV Conversion cable and RCA cable.
- Press the SOURCE button on the remote control to select YPBPR input source, then press the ENTER button to perform your selection.
- '\'O' Note: YPBPR's audio signal comes from the common AV IN terminal.




BASIC CONNECTION

CONNECTING TO HDMI CONNECTOR

HDMI (High—Definition Multimedia Interface) is the first all digital consumer electronics A/V interface that supports uncompressed standard. One jack supports both video and audio information.

This can be applied only if there is the HDMI output connector on the external equipment.

- 1. Connect an HDMI cable between the HDMI output connector on the LED TV and the DVD/ set-top-box.
- Repeatedly press the SOURCE button on the remote control to select HDMI input source, then press the ENTER button to perform your selection.
- Note: No sound connection is needed for a HDMI connection.




BASIC CONNECTION

CONNECTING TO A HEADPHONE

You can connect a headphone to your LED TV if you wish to watch a TV program without disturbing the other people in the room.


Insert a headphone into the 3.5mm mini-jack terminal on the LED TV, the sound is heard through the headphone.



☆ **Note**: Prolonged use of headphones at a high volume may damage your hearing.

CONNECTING TO COAXIAL OUTPUT

- 1. Connect the Coaxial cable from your Amplifer to Coaxial output of LED TV.
- 2. You can enjoy the audio from the TV via your home theater system.
- Note:SPDIF output(OFF,PCM, AUTO)can be selected in AUDIO MENU setup.



BASIC OPERATION

SELECTING ON SCREEN LANGUAGE

When you start using your LED TV for the first time, you must select the language which will be used for display menus and Indications.

- 1. Press the MENU button to display the menu.
- 2.Press the **◄/▶** button to select OPTION MENU.
- 3. Press the ▼/▲ button to select OSD Language item.
- 4. Then press the Enter button to select your language menu, Press the ∇/Δ , $\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$ button to select OSD Language.
- 5. When you are satisfied with your choice, press the MENU button to return to normal TV viewing.

CHOOSING A TV CHANNEL

Press the CH+ or button to increase channel number.

Press the CH- or button to decrease channel number.

You can select the channel number directly by pressing 0 to 9 buttons three times.

Note:

After select the digit button, the digit will be memorized. You can return to the previously selected program by pressing.

SELECTING INPUT SOURCE

You can select the source by press the SOURCE button on the top of the panel or press the SOURCE button on the remote control. Then press ENTER to confirm.



FIRST TIME INSTALLATION

First Time Installation also can be activated in the SETUP menu.

Note: If you do First Time Installation and select Auto Tuning, all TV programs will be update, but you can select "Yes" to install the factory preset channel lists during the installation.

Select Language

Press $\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$ button on the remote control to select the language to be used for menus and message. Press $\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$ button on the remote control to highlight Country menu. Press $\blacktriangleleft/\triangleright$ button on the remote control to select the country you want to.



Press ENTER button to enter Auto Tuning Setup.

TV Connection Setup

Press **◄**/▶ to select tune type among Antenna ,Cable, Satellite.

Tune Type

Press ◀/▶ to select digital type among DTV, A TV and DTV+ATV.



If you select DVB-S, then you must setup the Dish of the local satellite.

If you select Cable DVB-C, then you must setup the following items: Tune Type

Press ◀/▶ to select tune type between DTV,ATV and DTV+ATV.

Scan Type

Press ◀/▶ to select scan type between Full and Network Scan.

Frequency

Press ◀/▶ to select frequency between Auto and 770000.

Network ID

Press **◄**/▶ to select network ID between Auto and 65535.

Symbol(ks/s)

Press ◀/▶ to select symbol rate between Auto and 6900.

After confirming Tuning Setup by pressing ENTER button to channel tuning:

During channel tuning, you can press MENU and left arrow button on the remote control to skip tuning.









CHANNEL MENU

Press SOURCE button to select Antenna or Cable, Satellite, ATV.

Press MENU button to display the main menu.

Press **◄**/**▶** button to select CHANNEL in the main menu.

Press ▼/▲ button to select DVB-C Manual Tuning, then press ENTER button to enter sub-menu.

Frequency

Press ◀/▶ button on the remote control to select option you want.

Symbol(ks/s)

Press ◀/▶ button on the remote control to select option you want type: AUTO or 6900.

QAM Type

Press ◀/▶ button on the remote control to select QAM type: 16QAM,32QAM,64QAM,128QAM,256QAM.

Press ▼/▲button to select **Search**, then press ENTER button to start tuning,

Program Edit

Note: Program Edit function is available only when the LCN is set to OFF.

Press ▼/▲button to select Program Edit, then press ENTER button to enter sub-menu.

Press the four colored key is the shortcut key for function operation.

First press ▼/▲ to highlight the channel you want to delete or rename or move or skip, then:





Press the Red button to delete the channel.

Press the Yellow button to set the channel to moving state, then press ▼/▲to move it to the position you want to put.

Press the Blue button to skip the select channel. (Your TV set will skip the channel automatically when using CH+/- to view the channels.)

Press the FAV button to add the channel to your favorite list.

Press the ▼/▲button to page up or down the channel.



Signal Information

Press ▼/▲button to select Signal Information then press the ENTER button to see the detail information about the signal. Only available when there is signal under DTV.

CI Information

Press ▼/▲button to select CI Information then press the ENTER button to see the detail information about the signal. Only available when there is signal under DTV.

5V antenna power

Press ▼/▲button to select 5V antenna power . Press ◄/▶button to select On or OFF, about the signal. Only available when there is signal under DTV.

LCN

Press ▼/▲button to select LCN function . Press ◄/▶ button to select On or OFF, about the signal. Only available when there is signal under DTV.

Software Update (USB)

Press ▼/▲button to select Software Update function . Press ENTER button to Confirm update.

Please prepare USB and relevant update files before software update. Then insert USB and choose this option. You should do according to system hint and remember not to pull out USB before finishing software update.

CHANNEL MENU (SATELLITE)

Channel Menu

Press SOURCE button to select Satellite.

Press MENU button to display the main menu.

Press **◄**/▶ button to select CHANNEL in the main menu.



- 1. Press ▼/▲button to select the option that you want to select in the CHANNEL menu.
- 2. Press ENTER button on the remote control to enter sub-menu.
- 3. Press MENU button to return back to the previous menu.

Auto Tuning

Press ▼/▲button to select Auto Tuning, then press ENTER button to enter sub-menu.

Press ▼/▲button to select function item.



Press ▼/▲button to select Search ,Press "OK" to Search.

Satellite

Press **◄**/▶button to select Different types of satellites.

Channel Type

Press ◀/▶ button to select channel type: All ,Free, Scramble.

Service Type

Press ◀/▶ button to select service type: All, DTV, Radio.

Scan Mode

Press ◀/▶ button to select scan mode: AUTO, Blind Scan, Network, Preset, Fast Scan.

Note. Fast Scan is mainly for the countries Belgium, Netherlands, Luxemburg, Hungary and for a few customers in Germany and Austria.

Unicable

Press **◄**/▶ button to select Unicable: Off, ON.

Search

Press Enter button to start Satellite auto scan.

Auto Tuning Status

Press ENTER button to start channel searching.

Press ◀ or EXIT button to tuning. Press Menu to exit tuning.





DVB-S Manual Tuning

Press V/▲button to select DVB-S Manual Tuning, then press ENTER button to enter sub-menu.

Satellite

Press **◄**/**▶** button to select different types of satellites.

TransPonder

Press **◄**/▶ button to select TransPonder

unicable

Press **◄**/**▶** button to select OFF.ON.

Network Scan

Press **◄**/**▶** button to select OFF, ON.

Scan Mode

Press ◀/▶button to select scan mode ALL, Free, Scramble.

Service Type

Press ◀/▶ button to select Service Type: All, DTV, Radio.

Search

Press ENTER button to start Satellite Search.

TV Type

DVDs are produced in a variety of screen aspect ratios. This menu enables you to select one of the three aspect ratios:



- 4:3 PS (Normal)
- 4:3 LB (Normal)
- 16:9 (Wide)
 - Select the most appropriate aspect ratio for the DVD being viewed.

4:3PS (Normal)

Normal Pan and Scan is used for most normal television broadcasts and it is the default setting. It has an aspect ration of 4:3. If you select this setting when viewing a DVD the picture will fill the screen but, you will not see the left and right edges of the picture.



4:3LB (Normal)

Normal Letter Box will show the DVD in its original aspect ratio so depending on the size of your television screen, you may see black borders above and below the picture.

16:9 (Wide)

Choose this setting if you have a widescreen television.




PassWord

No picture or black and white picture	Adjust the colour settings.Check that the broadcast system selected is correct.
"Unknown" message Sound and picture	 Make sure that the power cord is firmly connected to the PC or the video sources. Make sure that the PC or video sources are switched on. Try to identify the electrical appliance that is affecting the set and
interference	move it further away.
Blurred or snowy picture, distorted sound	Check the direction, location and connections of your aerial.
Remote control does not work	 The battery in the remote control may be exhausted. The battery may be improperly installed. Check that there is no obstruction between the remote control and the remote (infrared) sensor. Ensure that there is no strong light shining on the remote control's infrared sensor.
The LCD TV does not turn on	Be sure the power cord is plugged on.
The image is too light or too dark	Adjust the brightness and Contrast.
On PC mode, horizontal bars appear to flicker, jitter or shimmer on the image	Adjust the Phase.


