Inserting Micro SD Card

Note: Please choose a branded Micro SD card and format it on computer before use. The camera supports up to 32GB, Class 10 (Non Ultra).

Installing and removing battery

- 1. Slide latch across and lift battery cover up to open.
- 2. Correctly install battery into camera as indicated by +/- symbols and direction of arrows marked on the
- battery until it's in place.

 3. Replace cover
- 4. To remove battery pull battery door latch upwards

Charging

1. Charging can be done by either connecting the camera to a computer or power adapter (not included)

Getting Started

Press & hold the mode button on the front of the camera for 3 - 5 seconds to turn it on. Press the mode button to cycle through camera modes.

- 1. Video mode- to record video
- 2. Photo mode- to take pictures

3. Playback mode- to view videos and pictures 4. Setup menu.

Video mode

When in recording mode symbol is displayed on top of screen, press red shutter button to start and stop recording. A red circle appears next to this symbol and flashes whilst recording.



Photo mode

When in photo mode symbol is displayed on top of screen, press red shutter button to take a picture.



Playback mode

Use the up & down buttons to cycle through video and picture taken on the device. Press the red shutter button to select & play. For file storage & playing after you are done recording, use a the USB cable provided to export the videos and pictures onto a computer to play. Or you can take the Micro SD card out and access the image data with a card reader.
