Inserting Micro SD Card

This camera is compatible with 8GB, 16GB, 32GB and 32GB Micro SD, Micro SD HC and Micro SDXC memory cards. **Note:** Please choose a branded Micro SD card and format it on computer before use. The camera supports up to 32GB, Class 10 (Non Ultra). For 64GB (2K,4K recordings) requires Ultra 1 Class 10 card. We recommend using brand name memory cards for maximum reliability in high-vibration activities.



Installing and removing battery

- 1. Press the battery switch down and slide cover outwards. Cover will lift upwards.
- 2. Correctly install battery into camera as indicated by +/- symbols and direction of arrows marked on the battery until it's in place.
- 3. Replace cover
- 4. To remove battery pull battery tab upwards



Micro SD Cards:

This camera is compatible with 8GB - 64GB Micro SD, Micro SD HC and Micro SDXC memory cards. You must use a Micro SD card with a Class 10 speed rating. We recommend using brand name memory cards for maximum reliability in high-vibration activities.

Charging the battery:

- 1. Connect the camera to a computer or USB power supply with cable supplied.
- 2. The charging LED indicator light turns red while the battery is charging.
- 3. The charging LED indicator light will turn off when the battery is fully charged.
- 4. Charging battery icon flashes on front and rear screen when the camera is turned on.
- 5. Charging time is approx 3.5 hours

Note: If recording is occuring when the battery reaches 0% the camera will save the file and power off.

Getting Started

Press & hold the shutter ON/OFF button on the top of the camera for 3 - 5 seconds to turn it on or off. The GC300 is a touch screen model allowing you to change settings by simply touching the rear screen.

Mode settings

Touch the bottom of the rear screen to access 9 shooting modes. Select the shooting mode and click on the right lower corner settings icon to enter the settings for this mode. For each mode the settings will different. Press the X icon to exit settings.

Video mode

When in recording mode a video camera symbol is displayed on top left of screen and a red circle appears lext to it. Press the shutter button to start and stop recording. The shutter button and the circle on the screen now flashes red and a counter appears whilst recording.



Photo mode

When in photo mode a camera symbol is displayed on top left of screen, press the shutter button to take a picture. A counter appears showing the amount of pictures you can take with the available memory left on the Micro SD card.



Playback mode

In the bottom left corner, press the play icon. Press the arrow buttons to choose files. Press the play button icon to play the footage. Press the pause icon to pause. Press the return icon to exit. For file storage & playing after you are done recording, use a the USB cable provided to export the videos and pictures onto a computer to play. Or you can take the Micro SD card out and access the image data with a card reader.
